This LST (Landing Ship, Tank) was originally known as LST-325 during the Second World War, USNS LST-325 during its arctic operations in the 1950's, and later L-144 (*A/G Syros*) while it was in the service of the Greek Navy. This vessel was used to land battle-ready tanks, troops & supplies. For one week this summer, the USS LST Ship Memorial will be available for touring in America's Hometown.
